Meeting brought to order by Harold Hogan, February meeting minutes were approved.

A question was raised about the type of bank account is set up for the Treasury funds. Bill Sturgeon reported it is a checking account, not an interest accruing account. No change was made.

Motion was made for a \$500 scholarship donation to the college in trade for the meeting room. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion regarding the offer by the VFW for their facility as a meeting room. Requirement would be that at least one member of our chapter is a veteran of a foreign war. We would have the facility exclusively on meeting date. But we would have to guarantee the “veteran” status. Cost would be \$300 per year. No consensus was reached.

Steve opened discussion as to contacting Casting for Recovery to offer the organization the donated 900 trout flies in our possession, which was passed unanimously.

Steve discussed the BANFF Film Festival held in Blairsville on March 28. Two volunteers agreed to an a table, tie flies, promote our chapter at the event held at Union County Fine Arts Center.

Larry Bundy suggested the chapter follow the bylaws to hold four chapter board meeting per year as the bylaws specify.
